Weekends- group seating is available by reservation for indoor or outdoor seating, if available. We do not hold reservations for more than 15 minutes past the scheduled time. If you find that you are running behind, please call the winery to make us aware. GROUP POLICIES:

- Upon arrival, <u>do not</u> go to the bar to order drinks. Rather, see the hostess so she/he may escort you to your reserved table. A server will be assigned and will get all guests' drinks/food orders.
- Groups of 10+ without a reservation will be refused service if there are not any tables available.
- Any alcohol brought on to the premises will be confiscated & will result in your party being denied entry on to the property. Outside alcohol is absolutely prohibited and against the law in the State of Ohio. The individual will face prosecution and/or fine is they do not comply.
- Individuals within a party of 10+ that are determined to be intoxicated on arrival will result in the entire group being asked to leave. Any attempt by a minor in a group to consume alcohol will result in the entire group being asked to leave.
- Transportation companies will be contacted to collect groups that are unruly, intoxicated or otherwise disruptive to our other guests. We encourage "wine tours" and discourage "party buses."
- If you have a time constraint, please let us know at the time of the reservation so the server can adjust accordingly. If you do have limited time, it is the responsibility of the group to order in a timely matter and to let your server know.
